GK: Yeah, the people were so nice in the morning, we would wait here on Ninth St. for the bus and a man would come down and say: Going to the cannery? Yeah? Come on in. You would think nothing of it. And now you would be so scared. But people were so different. You could trust anybody. It's really—now if somebody offered me a ride I don't think so.

AC: But you know, that bus fare was a big deal. Even if it was just five cents, ten cents. How much was the bus?

GK: Five cents.

AC: Saving that--getting that ride meant an extra nickel and that added up.
