**Remembers Mexican Hollywood**

TU: Down where Todds Shipyard was – there was a colony of Mexicans. They called it Mexican Hollywood. They would sew, they would sew, and they all look so beautiful, they would come out looking like queens. They were very pretty girls at that time. The Slavs started to call it Mexican Hollywood. They had the money but they didn't know how to put themselves together.
